CPAP/BiPAP SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Never immerse your CPAP unit in water
- Never plug in your CPAP unit if wet.
- Never plug you CPAP unit into an electrical outlet that is supplying power to another appliance.
- Never use your CPAP unit with an extension cord.
- Never try to repair your CPAP unit.
- If renting, call NRS to have your unit replaced.
- If your unit was purchased by insurance contact an approved repair center or check with NRS about a maintenance agreement.
- Follow all oxygen safety precautions if using supplemental oxygen with your CPAP/BiPAP unit.
- Clean and disinfect mask, tubing and humidifier regularly.
- Replace filters when dirty.
- Wipe off machine with a clean damp cloth as needed.
